



# Miki's Pro Soccer Camp Rules

## Come Prepared

1. Bring your soccer ball
2. Wear soccer shorts or warm-ups, t-shirt, long soccer socks,
3. Shin Guards. Socks must cover the shin guards completely.
4. Soccer shoes (cleats or turf shoes.)
5. Plenty of water.

## Players are NOT allowed to have any of the following equipment:

1. Jewelry. No jewelry, with the exception of medical tags, is permitted.
2. Any type of hard or plastic cast must be wrapped and approved prior to play.
3. NO HEADWARE, CAPS OR METAL HAIR CLIPS can be worn unless approved by camp staff.
4. NO EYEWEAR with any type of hard material deemed, by camp staff, a potential danger to the player or others is permitted. (Plastic prescription goggles are allowed.)
5. Players with open wounds or visible blood on their body or uniform will not be permitted to play until the wound is properly covered and the uniform changed to the satisfaction of camp staff.

## Behavior Guidelines

1. Respect other participants, the instructors, the facilities and all equipment.
2. Teasing and/or "put downs" will not be tolerated at camp.
3. Use of inappropriate language will not be tolerated – No Cursing!
4. No headphones will be allowed while training
5. Cell phone use will not be allowed during training sessions or camp activities.
6. No drugs, tobacco, alcohol or weapons will be permitted at any time during the camp.
7. Campers may not leave an assigned activity area without permission of the supervising staff.
8. Campers must be picked up by a parent promptly at camp end - supervision will not be provided after that time.

*Any other rules specific to a camp will be discussed at camp.*

## Guidelines and Consequences

In order to provide a pleasant environment and to insure the safety of our campers and staff, disruptive, destructive and/or dangerous behavior by campers will not be allowed. Such behavior will result in the camper being removed from the current program. If the behavior continues, the camper will be dismissed from camp. When a participant is dismissed from camp for disruptive behavior there will be NO REFUND.

## Any of the following will result in IMMEDIATE dismissal from camp:

1. Endangering the health or safety of others.
2. Possession of firearms, weapons, explosives, etc.
3. Possession of illegal drugs, alcohol, cigarettes
4. Damage or destruction of property
5. Theft
6. Fighting
7. Leaving camp without permission

**Inclement Weather:** In the case of poor weather, safety comes first. If we are unable to continue, we will cancel our session. There are no refunds or makeup dates for cancelled sessions.

**Damage or Loss of Property:** Camper's Parent/Legal Guardian will be financially responsible for any and all damages caused by camper. Parent/Legal Guardian will be billed for damage to facilities or equipment.
